Visits to Belarus

CCP Director Linda Walker was one of almost 400 people from 12 countries who took part in an International Conference in Minsk this month to commemorate the anniversary. Organised by German charity IBB, the conference included workshops on medical and social projects; demands for further research into the effects of low level radiation and for a halt to the building of new nuclear power plants; and plans were made to continue and expand the work of the European Chernobyl Network of which CCP is a Founder Member.

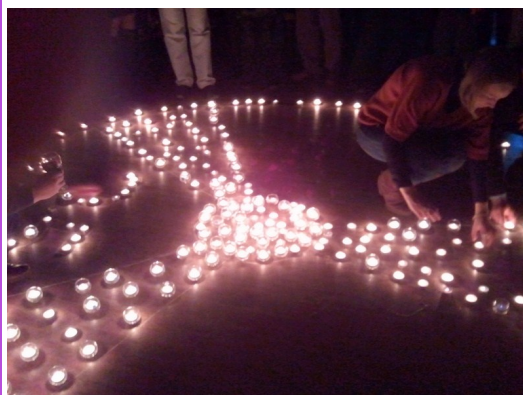
